SECTION V - REACTIVITY DATA

STABILITY: Stable
INCOMPATIBILITY: Dissolves in hydrofluoric acid & produces a corrosive gas, silicone tetrafluoride
HAZARDOUS DECOMPOSITION PRODUCTS: None
HAZARDOUS POLYMERIZATION: Will not occur

SECTION VI - HEALTH HAZARD DATA

EFFECTS OF OVEREXPOSURE:

ACUTE AND CHRONIC:

EYES: Not a primary eye irritant. Particles may cause mechanical irritation.
SKIN: Mechanical irritation possible but unlikely. Not absorbed through skin.
INHALATION: Excessive inhalation of crystalline silica dust may result in respiratory disease including pneumoconiosis, silicosis and pulmonary fibrosis. Crystalline silica is listed by IARC as a Group 2A carcinogen based on "sufficient evidence in experimental animals" and "limited evidence" with respect to humans.

EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES:

EYES: Flush with running water to remove particles. If irritation continues, see physician.
SKIN: Wash with water.
INHALATION: Gross inhalation - Remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Call a physician.
INGESTION: If swallowed, dilute with water. Never give fluids if the victim is unconscious or having convulsions. Call a physician.
TARGET ORGANS: Lungs.
MEDICAL CONDITIONS WHICH MAY BE AGGRAVATED: Excessive exposure to any dust may aggravate pre-existing respiratory conditions.

SECTION VII - PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFE HANDLING AND USE

STEPS TO BE TAKEN IN CASE MATERIAL IS RELEASED OR SPILLED: Sweep or vacuum material from spillage into a waste container for disposal. Avoid dusty conditions.
WASTE DISPOSAL METHOD: This material can be disposed of as an inert solid in a landfill.
